## VACCINATION IS KEY TO PROTECT PIGLETS FROM DISEASES ON THE FARM

Prevention is far less expensive than treatment. Vaccination is undoubtedly one of the **most valuable tools** to minimize the impact of pathogens on farms nowadays, aiming to achieve the goal of producing **high-quality piglets**.

Vaccination is one part of a larger scenario where herd management, building hygiene, vector control, biosecurity, etc., are elements that **influence the efficacy** of vaccination

When vaccination does not perform as expected, it is a **priority to correctly interpret the failures**.

Before blaming the vaccine, we should ask: did the vaccine fail us or did we fail the vaccine?

Vaccination Management encompasses the primary causes of vaccination failures.



Veterinarians are actively involved in on-farm vaccination :

- o Farm health
- o Selection of vaccines
- o Vaccination protocols
- o Vaccination schedule



But sometimes, the final steps of the process can only be performed by field personnel :

- o Storage and preparation of the vaccine
- o Follow-up of the animals



In such cases, how to be sure that vaccination is properly done ?

Farm teams are not always aware of good vaccination practices and it is almost impossible for vets to check each vaccination that is done in the field.


